RECEIVING THE SACRAMENTS

The seven Sacraments of the Church were instituted by Christ to confer grace.

Sacrament of Baptism. Call the office to register for Parent Pre-Baptismal Instruction. For adults seeking to enter the Church and be Baptized, contact our Religious Education Office.

Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). Children in our religious education program and school are prepared for Confession at age seven as part of First Communion preparation.

Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Children in our religious education program and school are prepared for First Communion at age seven. Adults seeking First Communion should contact our Religious Education Office. To request a visitation for Holy Communion to the Sick, contact our parish office.

Sacrament of Confirmation. Young people in our parish are prepared for reception of Confirmation in the ninth grade (age 14). Adults seeking Confirmation should contact our Religious Education Office.

Sacrament of Marriage. Couples planning for Marriage are to contact a parish priest or deacon one year in advance to set the wedding date and plan for pre-Cana instruction.

Sacrament of Holy Orders. If you believe you have, or someone you know has, a vocation to the Priesthood or Diaconate, please contact one of our parish priests.

Anointing of the Sick. For the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, which is administered by a Priest, a person or an immediate family member must make the request. Late night requests may not be able to be answered until the next day.



Dear Parishioners,

It is the Fourth of July. On this Independence Day weekend, I remind you that our Lord has created us to be free, and at the same to be holy. As we should have all learned from the Spider-Man movies, "with great power comes great responsibility." We have freedom, both in our own lives, and in our nation, and our challenge is taking that gift of freedom – of liberty – and to use it well, as Christ would have us use it. To each of you and your families, I say may God bless America, this year and for ages to come! His truth is marching on!

This weekend we will be celebrating our nation - - its freedoms, its promise, and all of the wonderful benefits that it has brought to the world. And this year, like last year, most of us will be spending the summer holidays, including this one here in the United States, as international travel, while in the process of rebooting itself, is still not on the radar for many -- though that is changing quickly, thank goodness.

But that doesn't mean we can't take a peak overseas -- and indeed around the world -- and take a look at some of the most interesting Catholic outposts on Earth. Yes, the Catholic Church is everywhere... and in this column I want to celebrate some of the more far flung locations and distant sites of some of Catholic Churches. So, pack the sun tan lotion, and the parka; the sandals, and the snow shoes; the fanny pack, and the mountain climbing gear. We're going on a trip (sorry no frequent flyer miles accrue). Here is our Catholic Church -- not just in the Dover and Marydel, but in some of the most isolated places on Earth.



Holy Cross Church, Easter Island. This is Holy Cross Church... not in Dover... but on Easter Island, in the Pacific Ocean. It is 2,400 miles from Chile and 4,700 miles from Hawaii (but a mere 1,100 miles from the next Church on Juan Fernandez Island). Native carvings of the saints, many in the motif of the Easter Island head carvings, pepper the Church.



Sacred Heart Church, Pond Inlet, Nunavut, Canada. The Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in Pond Inlet, Nunavut (Northwest Territory), Canada had been the northernmost Catholic Church in the world, from 1929 until 1954 (it is about 1,200 miles from the North Pole). A Church in Barrow, Alaska now holds that title. Built in 1929, the Church of the Sacred Heart has 160 registered parishioners and is staffed by Priests from the Order of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate.



Thjodild's Church, Greenland. Where was the first Church in the western hemisphere built? It was built in Greenland. Erik the Red, a Viking, arrived in Greenland in 985 and built this Catholic Church for his wife, Thjodhild, a recent convert to Christianity. The current Church is a rebuild of the original and is known as Thjodild's Church. It is not a currently used Church. Is there a Catholic Church in Greenland today? Read on to the next paragraph to find out!





Christ the King Church, Greenland. Catholicism was banned in Greenland from the 18th century until 1953. The only active Catholic Church in Greenland today, was built in 1972: Christ the King Church. This Church has only 50 parishioners in this mainly Lutheran nation, and is located in Nuuk (Godthab), the capital city of Greenland.



St. Michael's Church, Croatia. St. Michael's church in Kijevo, Croatia, was built on a mountain fastness in the beginning of the 13th century; it fell into ruin over time. In 1930, the Church was rebuilt from its ruins and taken from being tiny church building to being a church of monumental size, thanks to the generosity of the local population. During the Second World War St. Michael's was destroyed and made into ruins again. The Church was partially rebuilt in 1948-49, with only one bell tower restored. During the troubles in Yugoslavia in the early 1990s, the Church was destroyed a third time in 1991; after which once it again restored, fully, to its current state.
